CONSTITUTION

1. NAME

THE NAME OF THE CLUB SHALL BE THE MANNUM ROOS NETBALL CLUB INCORPORATED (BUT REFERRED TO HEREIN AS "THE CLUB")

2. OBJECTS

THE OBJECTS OF THE CLUB ARE:

- A) TO TEACH, DEVELOP AND PROMOTE NETBALL IN THE AREA AND TO FOSTER GOOD FELLOWSHIP AMONG PARTICIPANTS.
- B) TO PROVIDE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT, A FRIENDLY ATMOSPHERE AND A PROGRAM DESIGNED TO DEVELOP THE PLAYERS' INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM NETBALL SKILLS.
- C) TO UPHOLD THE HIGHEST STANDARD OF SPORTING AND ETHICAL BEHAVIOUR IN OUR ON COURT PERFORMANCE AND MANAGEMENT PRACTICES.
- D) TO AFFILIATE WITH THE RIVER MURRAY NETBALL ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED (HEREIN REFERRED TO AS "THE RMNA")

3. PATRON/PATRONESS

THE APPOINTMENT OF A PATRON/PATRONESS SHALL BE IN THE TERM OF 1 YEAR, APPROVED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, BEING ELIGIBLE FOR RENOMINATION OF THE SAME POSITION THE FOLLOWING YEAR.

4. MEMBERSHIP

THE CLUB SHALL CONSIST OF:

- I. ALL PLAYERS
- II. LIFE MEMBERS
- III. SOCIAL MEMBERS
- IV. ALL OFFICERS OF THE CLUB
- V. PATRON/PATRONESS

VI. UMPIRES

VII. COACHES

- A) MEMBERSHIP FEES, AS SET BY THE CLUB AT THE FIRST COMMITTEE MEETING AFTER THE RMNA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, WILL BE PAID IN FULL BY THE THIRD MATCH OF THE DECLARED RMNA SEASON. ANY PLAYER WHO DOES NOT PAY THEIR MEMBERSHIP FEES BY THE REQUIRED TIME MAY NOT PLAY UNTIL FEES ARE PAID IN FULL UNLESS BY PRIOR ARRANGEMENT. AFTER THE THIRD MATCH OF THE RMNA SEASON ANY NON PLAYING MEMBERSHIP IS PAYABLE ON APPLICATION REQUEST.
- B) A MEMBER MAY RESIGN FROM MEMBERSHIP OF THE CLUB BY GIVING WRITTEN NOTICE OR VERBAL COMMUNICATION WITH THE PRESIDENT OR SECRETARY. ANY MEMBER SO RESIGNING SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY OUTSTANDING MEMBERSHIPS, WHICH MAY BE RECOVERED AS A DEBT DUE TO THE CLUB.
- C) A MEMBER MAY RESIGN FROM MEMBERSHIP OF THE CLUB BY GIVING WRITTEN NOTICE OR VERBAL COMMUNICATION WITH THE PRESIDENT OR THE SECRETARY. ANY MEMBER SO RESIGNING SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY OUTSTANDING MEMBERSHIPS, WHICH MAY BE RECOVERED AS A DEBT TO THE CLUB.

5. EXPULSION OF A MEMBER

- A) SUBJECT TO GIVING A MEMBER AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD OR MAKE A WRITTEN SUBMISSION, THE GENERAL COMMITTEE MAY RESOLVE TO EXPEL A MEMBER UPON A CHARGE OF MISCONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO THE INTERESTS OF THE CLUB.
- B) PARTICULARS OF THE CHARGE SHALL BE COMMUNICATED TO THE MEMBER AT LEAST ONE WEEK BEFORE THE MEETING OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE AT WHICH THE MATTER WILL BE DETERMINED.
- C) THE DETERMINATION OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMMUNICATED TO THE MEMBER, AND IN THE EVENT OF AN ADVERSE DETERMINATION THE MEMBER SHALL, (SUBJECT TO 5D BELOW) CEASE TO BE A MEMBER SEVEN DAYS AFTER THE COMMITTEE HAS COMMUNICATED ITS DETERMINATION TO THE MEMBER.
- D) IT SHALL BE OPEN TO A MEMBER TO APPEAL TO THE GENERAL COMMITTEE AGAINST THE EXPULSION. THE INTENTION TO APPEAL TO THE GENERAL COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMMUNICATED TO THE SECRETARY OF THE CLUB WITHIN SEVEN DAYS AFTER THE DETERMINATION OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE HAS BEEN COMMUNICATED TO THE MEMBER.

- E) IN THE EVENT OF AN APPEAL UNDER 5D ABOVE, THE APPELLANTS' MEMBERSHIP OF THE CLUB SHALL NOT BE TERMINATED UNLESS THE DETERMINATION OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE IS UPHeld BY THE MEMBERS OF THE CLUB IN A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING AFTER THE APPELLANT HAS BEEN HEARD BY THE MEMBERS OF THE CLUB, AND IN SUCH EVENT MEMBERSHIP WILL BE TERMINATED AT THE DATE OF THE SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING AT WHICH THE DETERMINATION OF THE COMMITTEE IS UPHeld.

6. OFFICERS

- A) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO BE APPOINTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SHALL INCLUDE:

- I. PRESIDENT
- II. VICE PRESIDENT
- III. SECRETARY
- IV. TREASURER

THE OFFICERS OF THE CLUB SHALL BE THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE PLUS:

- I. 1 RMNA DELEGATE
- II. 1 JUNIOR PLAYER REPRESENTATIVE
- III. 1 SENIOR PLAYER REPRESENTATIVE
- IV. SIX GENERAL COMMITTEE

THERE SHALL BE A MAXIMUM OF THIRTEEN (13) OFFICERS OF THE CLUB AND THEY SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE GENERAL COMMITTEE.

- A) ALL OFFICERS WILL BE ELECTED ANNUALLY AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING WITH ALL PRESENT OFFICERS BEING ELIGIBLE FOR RENOMINATION TO THE SAME POSITION THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
- B) ALL OFFICERS MUST PROVIDE A YEARLY POLICE CLEARANCE ONCE ELECTED.

7. POWERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING POWERS AND AUTHORITY FOR THE PURPOSES OF CARRYING OUT ITS OBJECTS, THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MAY, SUBJECT TO THIS ACT AND THE RULES:

- A) THE GENERAL MANAGEMENT OF THE CLUB; AND
- B) THE CONTROL OF THE FUNDS OF THE CLUB; INCLUDING
- C) ACQUIRE, HOLD, DEAL WITH, AND DISPOSE OF, ANY REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY; AND
- D) ADMINISTER ANY PROPERTY ON TRUST; AND
- E) OPEN AND OPERATE ADI (AUTHORISED DEPOSIT TAKING INSTITUTION) ACCOUNTS; AND
- F) INVEST ITS MONEYS;
 - I. IN ANY SECURITY IN WHICH TRUSTS MONEYS MAY, BY ACT OF PARLIAMENT, BE INVESTED; OR
 - II. IN ANY OTHER MANNER AUTHORISED BY THE RULES OF THE CLUB; AND
- G) BORROW MONEY UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE CLUB THINKS FIT; AND
- H) GIVE SUCH SECURITY FOR THE DISCHARGE OF LIABILITIES INCURRED BY THE CLUB AS THE CLUB SEES FIT; AND
- I) APPOINT AGENTS TO TRANSACT ANY BUSINESS OF THE CLUB ON ITS BEHALF; AND
- J) ENTER INTO ANY OTHER CONTRACT IT CONSIDERS NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE.
- K) TO CALL SPECIAL AND GENERAL MEETINGS OF THE CLUB; AND
- L) TO FILL ANY CASUAL VACANCY OF ANY OFFICE BEARER THIS SHALL BE A TEMPORARY POSITION UNTIL THE NEXT ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- M) IF BETWEEN COMMITTEE MEETINGS A MATTER IS RAISED, REQUIRING URGENT ATTENTION, THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MAY ACT BEHALF OF THE CLUB.
- N) ALL DECISIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL BE BINDING ON ALL MEMBERS.

8. PRESIDENT

- A) THE PRESIDENT SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL GENERAL AND SPECIAL MEETINGS WHEN PRESENT AND SHALL HAVE A CASTING VOTE AS REQUIRED. SHE/HE MAY ALSO ATTEND ALL SUB COMMITTEE MEETINGS.
- B) IN THE ABSENSE OF THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT AT ANY MEETING, A CHAIRPERSON SHALL BE ELECTED.
- C) THE PRESIDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PRESENTING THE ANNUAL REPORT AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- D) AND TO CARRY OUT ALL DUTIES LISTED IN THE CLUB JOB PROFILE.

9. VICE PRESIDENT

- A) THE VICE PRESIDENT SHALL ASSUME IN THE ABSENSE OF THE PRESIDENT ALL DUTIES NORMALLY CARRIED OUT BY THE PRESIDENT AND ASSIST THE PRESIDENT WHEN AND WHERE NECESSARY.
- B) AND TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES LISTED IN THE CLUB JOB PROFILE.

10. SECRETARY

- A) ATTEND AND RECORD A TRUE AND ACCURATE RECORD OF ALL MEETINGS AND THE MINUTES FOR CONFIRMATION AT THE NEXT RELEVANT MEETING.
- B) DEAL WITH ALL CORRESPONDENCE AND OTHER MATTERS ACCORDING TO THE DIRECTIONS SHE/HE MAY RECEIVE FROM THE GENERAL COMMITTEE OR ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- C) AND TO CARRY OUT ALL DUTIES LISTED IN THE CLUB PROFILE.

11. TREASURER

- A) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE RECEIPT OF ALL CLUB MONIES WHICH SHALL BE DEPOSITED WITHOUT DUE DELAY INTO THE CLUB'S' BANK ACCOUNT.
- B) BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ISSUING OF OFFICIAL RECEIPTS FOR M1Y RECEIVED AND RECEIVING OF OFFICIAL RECIPITS FOR MA1Y PAID.
- C) PAY BY CHEQUE ALL ACCOUNTS APPROVED BY THE GENERAL COMMITTEE. SUCH CHEQUES SHALL BE SIGNED BY 2 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS APPOINTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- D) SUBMIT TO EACH GENERAL MEETING A STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURE AND A CURRENT BANK BALANCE.

- E) PREPARE A BALANCE SHEET AND FINANCIAL STATEMENT AT THE END OF EACH YEAR TO BE AUDITED FOR SUBMISSIONS TO THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
 - THE AUDITOR SHALL NOT BE A MEMBER OF THE CLUB
- F) THE TREASURER MAY BE ASSISTED BY SUCH PERSONS APPOINTED BY THE GENERAL COMMITTEE.
- G) AND TO CARRY OUT ALL DUTIES LISTED IN THE CLUB JOB PROFILES.

12. GENERAL COMMITTEE

THE GENERAL COMMITTEE SHALL BE COMMITTED TO ALL ASPECTS TO ENSURE SMOOTH RUNNING OF THE CLUB.

13. RECORDER

- A) THE RECORDER WILL BE APPOINTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- B) THE RECORDERS' DUTIES INCLUDE:

RECORD KEEPING OF:

- A) NOMINATIONS OF PLAYERS AS PER RMNA CONSTITUTION
- B) FULL NAMES AND CONTACT DETAILS OF REGISTERED PLAYERS
- C) DATE OF BIRTH OF ALL PLAYERS
- D) ANY CHANGE OF NAME
- E) NUMBERS OF GAMES AND QUARTERS PLAYED
- F) THE DATE ON WHICH A MEMBER WAS ADMITTED TO THE CLUB
- G) NUMBER OF SENIOR GAMES PLAYED AND ADVISE THE PRESIDENT OF SIGNIFICANT MILEST1S IE 200 GAMES
- H) IF APPLICABLE, THE DATE AND REASON(S) FOR TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP
 - 1. II COLLECTION AND POSTING OF ALL SCORESHEETS AND RMNA BEST AND FAIREST ENVELOPES ON THE HOME GAMES AS PER RMNA CONSTITUTION.
 - 2. III ATTENDING TO ANY OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO RECORDING OF MATCHES OR MATCH RESULTS AS REQUIRED BY THE RMNA.
 - 3. IV RETAINING CLUB BEST AND FAIREST ENVELOPES.
 - 4. V AND TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES LISTED IN THE CLUB JOB PROFILE.

14. DELEGATES

THE CLUB SHALL HAVE 2 REPRESENTATIVES AT EACH RMNA DELEGATES' MEETINGS.

- A) 2 DELEGATES AND 1 PROXY DELEGATE (WHO MUST BE AGED 16 YEARS AND OVER) SHALL BE APPOINTED AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- B) AT LEAST 1 OF THESE DELEGATES MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE AND REPORT BACK TO THE COMMITTEE AT THE NEXT GENERAL MEETING OF THE CLUB.

15. DISQUALIFICATION OF A COMMITTEE MEMBER

THE OFFICE OF A COMMITTEE MEMBER SHALL BECOME VACANT IF A COMMITTEE MEMBER IS:

- A) DISQUALIFIED BY BEING A COMMITTEE MEMBER BY THE ACT.
- B) EXPELLED AS A MEMBER UNDER THESE RULES.
- C) PERMANENTLY INCAPACITATED BY HEALTH.
- D) ABSENT WITHOUT APOLOGY FROM MORE THAN 3 MEETINGS IN A FINANCIAL YEAR.

16. MEETINGS

MINUTES SHALL BE KEPT OF ALL MEETINGS OF THE CLUB, INCLUDING SUB COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

A) ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- I. THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SHALL BE AN OPEN MEETING TO BE HELD PRIOR TO THE RMNA ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- II. AT LEAST 14 DAYS NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL OR SPECIAL GENERAL MEETINGS OF THE CLUB SHALL BE GIVEN TO MEMBERS BY PUBLIC NOTICE IN A NEWSPAPER CIRCULATING IN THE MURRAYLANDS REGION AND BY CIRCULAR LETTER TO EXISTING MEMBERS.

III. ANY PROPOSED ALTERATIONS TO THE CONSTITUTIONS ARE TO BE IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY AT LEAST 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.

THE BUSINESS OF EACH MEETING SHALL INCLUDE

- PRESIDENT'S ANNUAL REPORT
- TREASURER'S REPORT
- ELECTION OF OFFICERS
- APPOINTMENT OF PATRON/PATRIS
- ELECTION OF 2 RMNA DELEGATES + 1 PROXY DELEGATE
- ELECTION OF RECORDER
- ANY OTHER BUSINESS AS DEEMED NECESSARY

IV. ANY PERSON PRESENT AND AGED 16 OR OVER, ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.

V. THE QUORUM OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING IS TO BE AT LEAST EIGHT MEMBERS OF THE CLUB.

B) GENERAL COMMITTEE MEETINGS

NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETINGS WILL BE DECIDED BY THE PRESIDENT OR SECRETARY AT THE END OF EACH GENERAL COMMITTEE MEETING.

C) SPECIAL GENERAL MEETINGS

A) MAY BE CALLED

- AT THE REQUEST OF THE PRESIDENT
- AT THE REQUEST OF 2 OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE MEMBERS SETTING FORTH THE OBJECT OF THE MEETING.

B) NO OTHER BUSINESS SHALL BE DEALT WITH.

C) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADVISE ALL COMMITTEE MEMBERS BY PHONE/FAX/EMAIL, THE TIME, DATE AND PURPOSE OF SUCH MEETING, WHICH SHALL BE CALLED WITHIN 7 DAYS OF RECEIVING THE REQUISITION.

D) EXECUTIVE MEETINGS

THE EXECUTIVE SHALL MEET AT SUCH TIME AND IN SUCH PLACES AS REQUIRED TO FULFIL THE FOLLOWING DUTIES:

- TO DEAL WITH LETTERS OF COMPLAINT
- TO DEAL WITH MATTERS ARISING FROM THE GENERAL MANAGEMENT OF THE CLUB.
- INTERPRETATION OF THE BY LAWS

I. THE QUORUM OF AN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING SHALL BE 3 MEMBERS, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE THE PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT.

II. ALL MATTERS DEALT WITH BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL BE MINUTED AND REPORTED BACK AT THE NEXT GENERAL MEETING.

E) QUORUM

THE QUORUM OF ALL GENERAL COMMITTEE AND SPECIAL GENERAL MEETINGS SHALL BE 50% PLUS 1 OF THE COMMITTEE MEMBERS ENTITLED TO VOTE.

F) VOTING

EACH COMMITTEE MEMBER SHALL HAVE 1 VOTE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE PRESIDENT, WHO HAS THE CASTING VOTE.

II PROXY VOTES SHALL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

17. LIFE MEMBERS

- A) LIFE MEMBERS SHALL BE AWARDED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMITTEE TO ANY MEMBER WHO HAVE PLAYED OR SERVED FOR 10 YEARS.
- B) SPECIAL CONSIDERATION MAY BE MADE TO DETERMINE WHETHER A MEMBER SHALL BE ENTITLED TO LIFE MEMBERSHIP BEFORE SERVING A TERM OF 10 YEARS, BECAUSE OF OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE CLUB.
- C) LIFE MEMBERS SHALL BE ISSUED WITH A SUITABLE BADGE OR MEDALLION TO BE PRESENTED AT THE ANNUAL PRESENTATION NIGHT.
- D) LIFE MEMBERS SHALL HAVE THE SAME PRIVILEGES AS OTHER MEMBERS OF THE CLUB AND MEMBERSHIP FEES WILL BE WAIVED.

18. COMPLAINTS/DISPUTES

A COMPLAINT MAY BE LODGED IN:

- A) ANY CASE, WHICH IT IS CLAIMED THAT ANY TEAM, MEMBER, OR OFFICIAL OF THE CLUB HAS NOT COMPLIED WITH THE RULES OF THE CLUB OR THE RULES OF NETBALL.
- B) ANY COMPLAINT LODGED, MUST BE MADE IN WRITING, AND ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY OF THE CLUB, WHO SHALL ENDEAVOUR TO ACTION WITH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE WITHIN 48 HOURS.
- C) ON RECEIVING THE COMPLAINT THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL DECIDE IF THE COMPLAINT CAN BE HANDLED BY A NEUTRAL EXECUTIVE

COMMITTEE MEETING OR WHETHER IT WARRANTS A FULL OR SPECIAL MEETING.

- D) IF AN EXECUTIVE MEMBER IS ASSOCIATED WITH ANY COMPLAINTS THEN THEY SHALL TAKE NO PART.

19. CONSTITUTIONS AND BY LAWS

- A) THE BY LAWS OF THE CLUB SHALL BE MADE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENLARGING UPON, EXTENDING AND DEVELOPING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONSTITUTION AND INTERPRETATION THEREOF.
- B) IF ANY MATTER IS NOT COVERED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND BY LAWS, THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE FINAL RIGHT TO DETERMINE THE MATTER.
- C) THE MAKING, ADDITION, ALTERATION, AND REPEAL OF THE CONSTITUTION MAY ONLY OCCUR AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING. SUCH AMMENDMENTS MUST BE FOREWARDED IN WRITING TO THE CLUB SECRETARY AT LEAST 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.
- D) THE MAKING, ADDITION, ALTERATION, AND REPEAL OF THE CONSTITUTION MAY ONLY OCCUR AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING. SUCH AMMENDMENTS MUST BE FOREWARDED IN WRITING TO THE CLUB SECRETARY AT LEAST 4 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING. A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING, CAN ALSO BE CALLED TO DEAL WITH THE MAKING, ADDITION, ALTERATION OR REPEAL OF THE BY LAWS WHICH SHALL BE CALLED WITHIN 7 DAYS OF RECEIVING THE WRITTEN REQUISITION.

20. DISSOLUTION

THE CLUB SHALL NOT BE DISOLVED OR WOUND UP, OR ITS NAME CHANGED WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF 3 QUARTERS OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT AT A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING CALLED FOR THAT PURPOSE. IF UPON THE DISOLUSION OR WINDING UP OF THE CLUB THERE REMAINS AFTER THE SATISFACTION OF ALL DEBTS AND LIABILITIES ANY PROPERTY WHATSOEVER THE SAME SHALL EITHER BE GIVEN OR TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER CLUB HAVING SIMILAR OBJECTIVES TO THE CLUB.

21. NON PROFIT CLAUSE

THE ASSETS AND INCOME OF THE CLUB SHALL BE APPLIED SOLEY IN FURTHERENCE OF ITS OBJECTIVES AND NO PORTION SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY TO ITS MEMBERS EXCEPT AS A BONAFAIDE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED OR EXPENSES INCURRED ON THE CLUB'S BEHALF.

22. FINANCIAL YEAR

THE FINANCIAL YEAR SHALL BE FROM 1ST DECEMBER TO 30TH NOVEMBER EACH CALENDAR YEAR

23. LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

- A) NO MEMBER SHALL BE PERSONALLY LIABLE TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE DISCHARGE OF ANY DEBTS OR LIABILITIES OF THE CLUB UPON ITS WINDING UP OR DISOLUTION.
- B) ANY PERSON, WHO WITH AUTHORITY AND IN GOOD FAITH, ENTERS INTO CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CLUB, SHALL BE IMDEMNIFIED BY THE CLUB AGAINST ANY LIABILITY THEREUNDER, SAVE AND EXCEPT WHERE SUCH LIABILITY WOULD OTHERWISE, BY LAW, ATTACHED TO THAT MEMBER IN RESPECT OF ANY NEGLIGENCE, DEFAULT, BREACH OF DUTY OR TRUST OF WHICH THAT MEMBER MAY BE GUILTY IN RELATION TO THE CLUB.
- C) ANY OFFICER OR AUDITOR OF THE CLUB SHALL BE INDEMNIFIED AGAINST LIABILITY INCURRED BY HIM OR HER, IN DEFENDING ANY PROCEEDINGS WHETHER CIVIL OR CRIMINAL, IN WHICH IN WHICH JUDGEMENT IS GIVEN IN HIS OR HERS FAVOR, OR IN WHICH HE OR SHE IS ACQUITTED.
